NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

ADOPTION AND APPROVAL OF 2010 PM10 MAINTENANCE PLAN AND REDESIGNATION REQUEST FOR THE COSO JUNCTION PLANNING AREA

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Governing Board of the Great Basin Unified Air Pollution Control District (GBUAPCD) will conduct a public hearing and consider for adoption the *2010 PM10 Maintenance plan and Redesignation Request for the Coso Junction Planning Area* (Coso PM10 Plan). The public hearing, and the Governing Board's consideration for adoption, will occur at the District Governing Board's regular meeting on **Monday, May 17, 2010 at 10:00 a.m.** in the Mono County Supervisors Chamber, Mono County Courthouse, 2nd Floor, Main Street (Highway 395), Bridgeport, California 93517. The public hearing on the Coso PM10 Plan is set for 10:15 a.m. The Coso PM10 Plan includes 1) a request to redesignate the area from nonattainment for the National Ambient Air Quality Standard for PM10 (federal standard) to attainment based on monitoring data and a modeling analysis, and 2) a maintenance plan that contains requirements to ensure the federal standard will not be violated in the future. Other actions related to the adoption of the Coso PM10 Plan may also be taken at the meeting. Members of the public will have an opportunity to submit written comments or make oral statements at the public hearing.

The Coso PM10 Plan is available for public review at the GBUAPCD's Bishop Office, 157 Short Street, Bishop, California, 93514, at the GBUAPCD web-site: www.gbuapcd.org, and at Inyo County Libraries in Independence, Big Pine, Bishop, Lone Pine, Death Valley and Tecopa, California. Copies of the Coso PM10 Plan on CD are free of charge upon request. Hardcopies are available at reproduction cost (\$25) and free of charge to Inyo, Mono and Alpine County residents. Written comments are invited, and should be addressed to Theodore D. Schade, Air Pollution Control Officer, Great Basin Unified Air Pollution Control District, 157 Short Street, Bishop, CA 93514. Written comments received by the close of business Wednesday, April 28, 2010, will be included in the staff report sent to the Governing Board members.
