Completes, assists, reviews, tracks and directs all aspects of air monitoring from field to final report presentation. Works directly with District management and other agency representatives to facilitate a smooth implementation of all air monitoring completed on and around Owens Lake.

Education and Experience:

Completion of a Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in a physical science, engineering or environmental field of interest and five years' experience in a scientific position; or completion of eight or more years in the air monitoring field achieving at least two years at the Technical Air Monitoring II level position or any combination of education and experience that provides the required knowledge, skills and abilities.
