**Owens Valley CA -- Taboose Fire**

**Special Statement**

The National Weather Service has issued a Red Flag Warning until 9pm tonight due to strong winds and low relative humidity.

**Fire Activity**

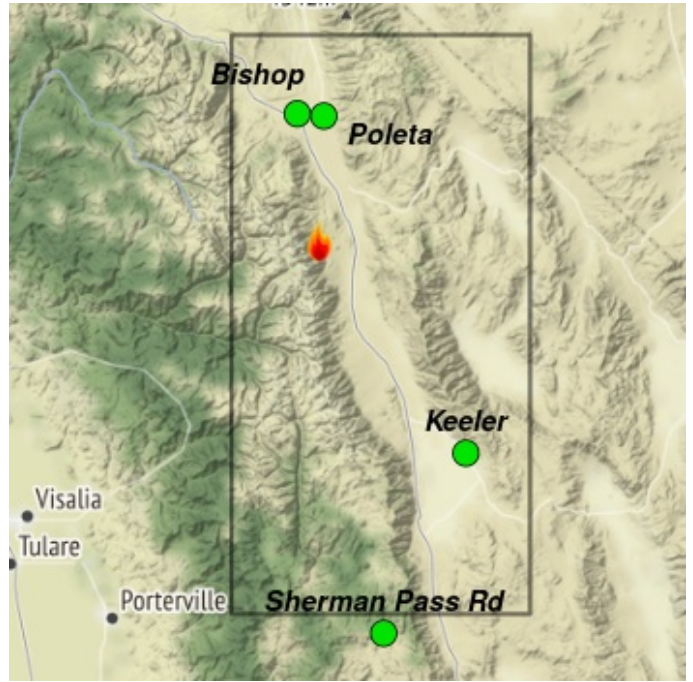
The Taboose Fire remains at 9,438 acres and is now 61% contained. There is minimal fire activity expected again today - crews will continue to patrol the area and extinguish hot spots. Winds are expected to pick up about 2pm today with the highest sustain winds between 5pm and 9pm. Crews are pre-positioned if any fire activity picks up from the wind.

**Smoke Production**

We do not anticipate any smoke from the Taboose Fire to impact communities, however, we will be closely monitoring the area during the wind event for any new starts that might send smoke into the Owens Valley.
